Electronic procurement system:

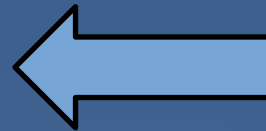
- based on open data and the OCDS

Legal frameworks:



- freedom of information, right to information, or access to information.
- Transparency – open data act
- release or reuse of public sector information
- privacy protection
- existing licenses or conditions of use for government data
- copyright law
- national security or similar

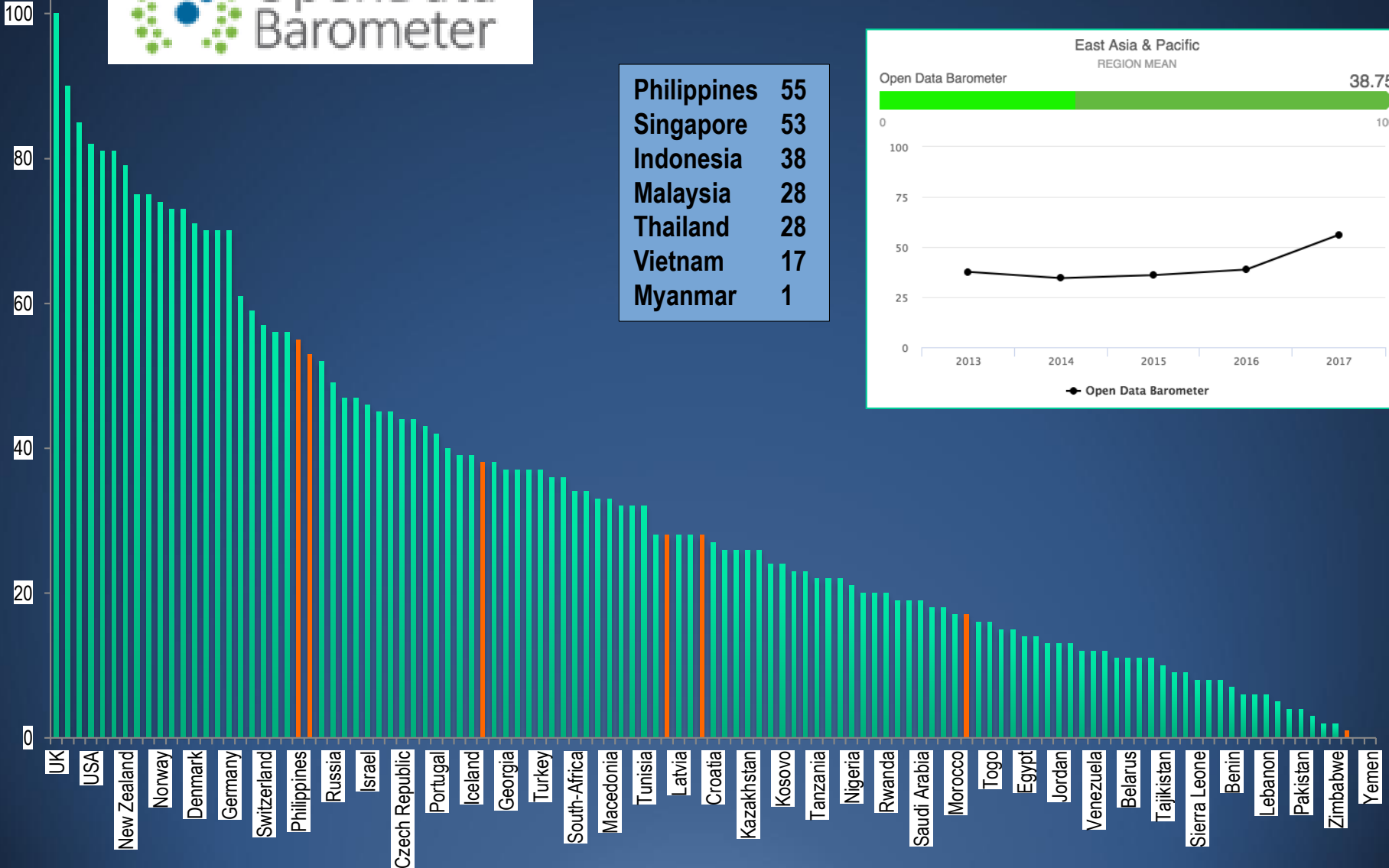


What do we need to make it happen?

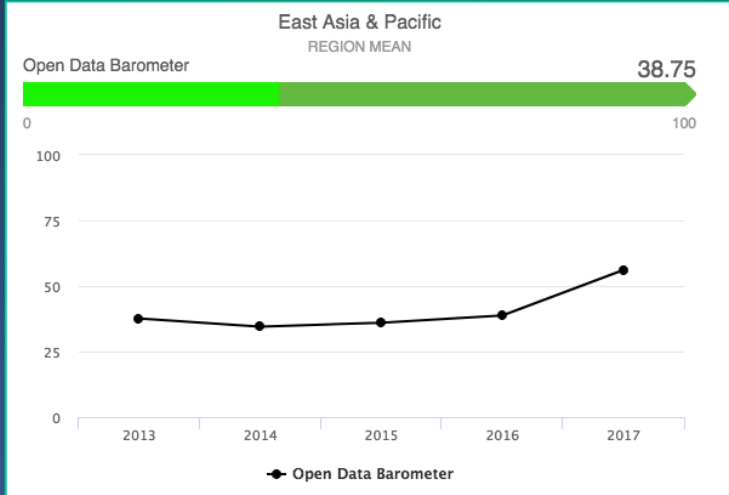
- Open data policies and regulations - work plans and M&E
- Institutional commitment at all levels
- Active coordination and interaction with the structures of the system of the central as well as the regional and municipal administrations
- Funds and other incentives
